

Geographic Location of Singapore

The gateway to Southeast Asia, at 136.8km north of the equator, between latitudes 103 degrees 38' E and 104 degrees 06' E – Singapore is a stone's throw from Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand and the Philippines with an airport served by 69 airlines.
